The chairman of their finance committee says: "Some of us were a little apprehensive less the loss of revenue and the outlay occasioned by the delay in getting into our building, the necessity of purchasing an entire new office supply, the inevitable initial expense in opening a new building and running it during the first few months, might find us with an adverse balance at the end of the year. But fortune has favored us and although our budget has just doubled that of last year, we have met every obligation and have given \$150, to extension work besides, and this while still collecting on the new building." This but emphasizes what has been proven scores of times that a new

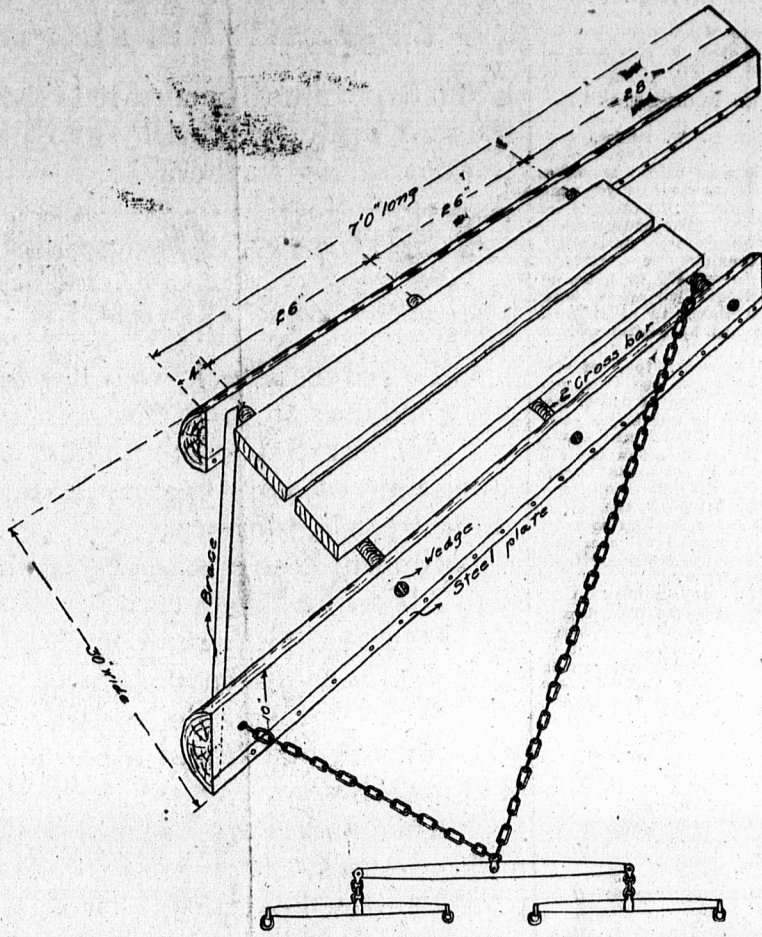

## WORLD'S TROPHY FOR FASTEST BOAT

The Wm. Wrigley Jr. Trophy for the power boat championship of the world represents over \$22,000. It is a perpetual trophy to be won each year by the club whose motor speed boat entry makes the best three out of five races in competition open to the world, free for all boats under 40 feet in length.

The Wm. Wrigley Jr. Trophy is a reproduction in silver of the famous "Flying Mercury" modelled by Giovanni da Bologna. The position of the figure is due to show Mercury presenting to Neptune a hydroplane motor speed boat, also in sterling silver. Neptune with his trident, dolphins and water surrounding are in prizes are a \$1,500 cash prize for the winner and a \$500 cash prize for the second boat.

The first races will be held on Chicago during the Water Carnival and Naval Review, August 10th to 17th inclusive, 1912. It is expected that there will be boats from Europe, from the Atlantic and Pacific Coasts, and two or more local entries. One of these is the new 24 cylinder hydroplane which Mr. James A. Pugh is having built by Wreckler.

Water Carnival week will include the other races in the Fourth Annual Regatta of the Western Power Boat Association, the International Yacht

Race between the Royal Canadian Yacht Club of Toronto on the Chicago Yacht Club, the Lipton Cup Race, Venetian night, parades, fireworks displays, naval battles, swimming and diving contests and exhibitions by United States sailors, Marine Corps, Revenue Cutter Service, Life Saving Service, North Chicago Naval Training Station and Illinois Naval Reserves.

This annual trophy will be a replica of the big \$5,000 trophy, and becomes the personal property of each year's event. To provide this trophy annually will require an endowment of about \$22,000.
