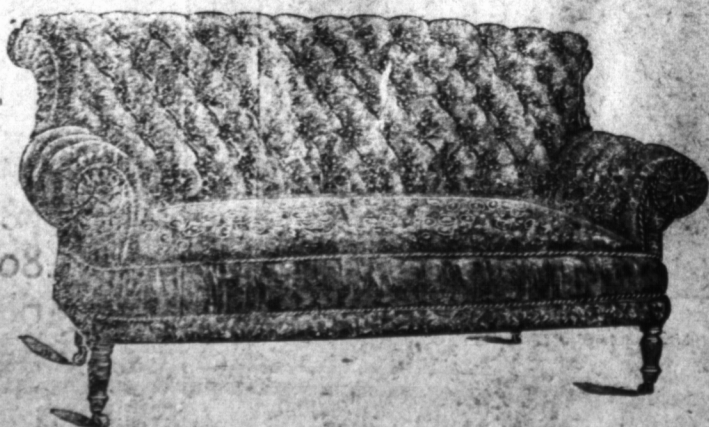

THE NEWFOUNDLAND TROUBLE.

Failing to secure a reciprocity treaty with the United States on fair terms, Newfoundland took measures to secure her inshore fisheries for her own people.

The new arrangement between Great Britain and the United States overrides the Newfoundland law. It gives American fishermen the right to use purse seines, which are forbidden by a law of Newfoundland, and also gives permission for American fishing captains to employ Newfoundlanders on their vessels.

The darkness in the northern part of the city on Thursday evening was due to a fuse blowing out and was not of long duration. Repairs were effected in reasonable time and the light restored.

THE LATE ARCHBISHOP BOND.

The death of Archbishop Bond, Primate of Canada, which occurred at Montreal on Tuesday last, was learned throughout the Dominion with profound regret.

Cummins, Acting Premier, that the vault at Summerside containing all official documents in connection with the Registry Office there was opened yesterday under the inspection of W. C. White, Registrar of Deeds, Charlottetown, and all documents are perfectly safe after the fire.

Synopsis of Canadian Homestead Regulations.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, exceeding 8 and 32, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 or more or less.
