CONTENTMENT.

Among the most thoroughly self-deceived people in the world are those who think that in the multiplication of things and possessions happiness or contentment lies. It is that matchless contemporary writer and clear thinker, Edward Carpenter, who has said: "Life is an art and a very fine art."

One of its first necessities is that you should not have more material in it—more chairs and tables, servants, houses, lands, bank shares, friends, acquaintances, etc., than you can really handle. It is no good pretending that you are obliged to have them. You must cut that nonsense short. If one's life is to be expressive, one does not want lumber in it, it must not be full of things that mean nothing or that mean the wrong thing."

Is there a great deal of work that each day brings? It is good if it is done rightly, and with the right mental attitude toward it. That we work is one of the laws of life. No one can be happy without it. There are thousands to-day who are unhappy and ill at ease to whom life seems even a burden, who could change all these conditions if they had something definite and useful regularly to do.

But here it is the middle ground as it is true in all phases of life. It is always the middle round that brings happiness and satisfaction—neither asceticism, on the one hand, nor over-indulgence, on the other. For most of us there will always be work to do; but Ruskin lifts a curtain when he says: "Pleasure comes through toil and not by self-indulgence and indolence. When one gets to love work his life is a happy one."—Ralph Waldo Trine.
