If the city will only undertake to keep it filled with water it will be conferring a great favor on all. 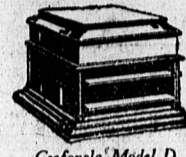

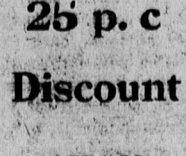

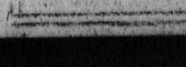
