## Grand Chance To Save Sugar If You're On Refreshment Committee

Will the Committee on Refreshments please come to order! All women's groups in Canada are exploring new avenues of service. Canteens for the boys and girls in uniform to raise funds for Red Cross or other war purposes are being operated across the country. In small towns and rural areas women's organizations are acting as hostesses for community banquets and parties. In districts near training stations, homes are being opened to men in the services. All these activities place a strain on your ingenuity and your sugar ration.  
But here's a grand chance to continue this hospitality and, at the same time, conserve sugar and help

the national nutrition campaign. Industries requiring sugar can use only 80 per cent of their normal consumption and restaurants are co-operating in saving sugar so it is up to Voluntary workers to do their share and cut down.  
The sole nutritive function of refined sugar is to give energy to the body. In the past, about 1-4 of the energy requirements of people in this country came from sweets. However, with our increasing appreciation of the value of protective foods we realize that it would be better for us to use less sugar and more cereals, fruits, vegetables and other foods which supply vitamins and minerals as well as energy. Small amounts of sugar help to make food palatable but are not necessary for health. Fruits with their natural sugars and mild sweetness do not spoil the appetite for other foods.  
When planning your desserts for canteens or large group suppers remember these sugar savers, quick breads, cookies, hot gingerbreads and muffins. Don't forget that shortcakes, when made with a biscuit dough basis, take very little sugar.  
These recipes are given for approximately 50 servings.

## Finance

NEW YORK, May 25 (AP)—There were scattered modest advances in today's stock market but trends generally were a shade lower.

The Associated Press average of 60 stock ended with a net loss of 1 of a point at 34.1. Transfers of 233,270 shares were among the smallest since August, 1940. They compared with 329,463 last Friday.  
Among Canadian stocks, Walkers common and preferred shares each gained 1-4 and Brazilian Tracton 1-8. Dome and Lake Shore Mines were off 1-8 while Canadian Pacific and International Nickel were unchanged.

Bethlehem Steel dropped nearly 2 points to a new 1942 bottom but attracted a little support at the last, and finished off 7-8 at 50 3-8. U.S. Steel conceded 1-2 and Republic Steel 3-8. Youngstown Sheet, on the other hand, was up 1-4. Expectations of expanding steel pressure on steel companies and other war producing industries was a factor of the day's offerings.  
Caterpillar Tractor, J. I. Case and J. C. Penney were losers of about a point each. Lesser recessions were posted for General Motors, Chrysler, Western Union, U. S. Rubber, Woolworth, DuPont, Aircraft, Sperry, Westinghouse, General Electric, Anaconda, Texas Co. and Electric Northern.

Lizette Myers gained a point and smaller plus marks were retained by Montgomery Ward, Sears Roebuck, Santa Fe, Southern Railway, Union Carbide, International Harvester, Boeing, United Aircraft, U.S. Gypsum and Air Reduction.

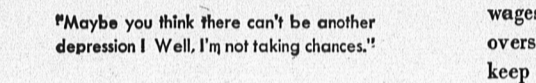

### BAKING POWDER BISCUITS

(Makes 100-2" biscuits)  
5 lbs. flour (20 cups)  
3-4 cup baking powder  
3 tablespoons salt  
1-4 lb. shortening  
2 quarts milk  
Sift dry ingredients. Work in the shortening. Then add the liquid very gradually. Form dough into shape, roll out on lightly floured board to 1-2 inch thickness. Cut. The top can be brushed with beaten egg, if desired. Bake at 450 F. for 15 to 20 minutes.

### Changes necessary to make the above recipe suitable for fruit shortcakes:

- 1. Reduce the salt to 1 tablespoon
- 2. Add 3-4 cup sugar
- 3. Increase the shortening to 2 lbs.
- 4. It may be necessary to add slightly more milk

### Variations of Tea Biscuits

### CHEESE PINWHEELS

To the recipe for Baking Powder biscuits, add the following ingredients:  
2 oz. butter, melted  
6 oz. cheese, grated  
Paprika  
Roll the biscuit dough 1-4 inch thick on lightly floured board. Spread with the melted butter, sprinkle very lightly with cheese and paprika. Roll up like a jelly roll and slice in 1/4-inch slices. Bake at 475 F. 15 minutes.

### MARMALADE PINWHEELS

To the recipe for Baking Powder biscuits, add 1 pint of marmalade:  
Roll the biscuit dough 1-4-inch thick on lightly floured board. Spread marmalade over the mixture. Roll and then slice in 3-4-inch slices. Bake at 475 F. for 15 minutes.

### BRAN MUFFINS

(Approximately 8 dozen)  
2 cups shortening (1 lb.)  
2 cups sugar (1 1-2 lbs.)  
12 eggs  
12 cups cooking bran (1 1-2 lbs.)  
8 cups milk  
12 cups sifted flour (3 lbs.)  
1 1/2 full cream baking powder (4 oz.)  
2 tablespoons salt (3-4 oz.)  
Cream shortening and sugar thoroughly. Beat the eggs and then add the bran and milk. Sift the dry ingredients and add to the mixture, being careful not to stir too much. Just bend in the flour till greased muffin pans 2-3 full and bake at 400 F. for 30 minutes.  
NOTE: If sour milk or buttermilk is used in place of sweet milk add 1 teaspoon soda for each pint of milk and decrease baking powder by one half.

twenty different fertility treatments for both manges and swedes. A three-year rotation of roots, oats, clover hay is followed, the clover sod being ploughed in the fall and the fertilizer treatments applied in the spring before the root is planted.

Mangels — From the standpoint of the root crop alone, an application of 1500 pounds of 4-8-8 fertilizer has given the highest net returns, but when all three crops in the rotation are considered the application of 750 pounds of 2-8-8 per acre. When manure and fertilizer were used together, the combination of 10 tons of manure and 500 pounds of 4-8-8 fertilizer proved to be the most economical combination. In view of the fact that neither 2-8-8 or 4-8-8 formulae are available in ready mixer form, a 4-8-10 fertilizer might be used by those desiring to purchase ready mixed goods.

Swedes — An application of 1000 pounds per acre of 2-12-6 fertilizer formula gives the most economical returns, both from the standpoint of the root crop alone and also when the three crops in the rotation were considered. This treatment, however, was only slightly superior to an application of 750 pounds of 4-12-6 per acre in net returns per acre after paying for fertilizer. When 10 tons of manure per acre was supplemented with fertilizer, the most economical returns were from an application of 500 pounds of 2-12-6.  
The use of powdered borax gave almost complete control of brown heart when applied at the rate of 10 pounds per acre.  
These treatments are applied after a clover sod and on medium clay loam soil. For lighter soil types or following a grass sod, heavier nitrogen applications may be found necessary and clover fertilizer formulae such as 5-8-10 or 5-9-8 would supply about the proper balance of phosphoric acid and potash for mangels, or 5-10-5 would be suitable for swedes.

## Attend To Lambs Two Weeks Old

It's lambing time and the male lambs to be castrated should be attended to when they are from two to three weeks old. Castration with Burdizzo pinchers is one of the best and most popular methods. It is bloodless and leaves no wound. For lambs the small style Burdizzo pinchers are mostly used.  
The best sheep men dock their lambs' tails when from one to two weeks old. Male lambs should be docked within one inch of the buttock, while a female should retain one or two more joints.  
An ordinary sharp knife is a common fall docking instrument. Have the lamb held by an attendant in a standing position with its feet outward, the two right feet held in one hand and the two left in the left hand. Locate the proper joint with the thumb of the left hand and place the knife on the proper spot just between the joints. Hold the tail straight out with the left hand and draw the knife quickly downward until the tail is severed. Lambs that are three weeks to a month old will sometimes bleed profusely. Bleeding may be stopped by

### SMALL ROCK GARDEN IS AN EASY TASK FOR HOUSEHOLDER

After spring raking and sprucing up of your yard is completed, if you still have a dismal looking forgotten corner near the fence or garage where the grass refuses to grow, you can permanently transform it from a familiar eye-sore to a beauty spot by making it into a small rock garden.  
All the material needed is a fair sized pile of old rocks and stones, a minimum of earth and a little bit

of imagination. As for plants, there are many interesting varieties, nearly all of which will grow almost anywhere with little or no attention.

Another unusual thing about most rock garden plants is that they can stand a lot of trampling from the neighbors' children and dogs and still come up smiling.  
New house owners can help to brighten up their muddy lots even before their grass has had a chance to take root, and there is usually enough stone or scrap brick around the average newly built house to provide a fine start for any rock garden.
