A TELEPHONE PROPERTY.

It is the public policy there to acquire and hold for the people the control and management of the telephone system.

There is a lesson in this for the governments, federal, provincial and city. The wealth of Rockefeller would not suffice to buy back again the public franchises and utilities which the Municipalities, Provinces and the Dominion have given away for nothing. It is too late to make good all the mistakes of the past, but care should be taken not to repeat them.

RURAL MAIL DELIVERY COMING

The one step that can be taken to give something like equal postal facilities to the country districts with those enjoyed by the cities is the establishment of rural postal delivery.

The Toronto Globe, which voices the views of the Government of Canada on most questions says: "Rural postal delivery on a more or less extensive scale is quite certain to be established and perhaps after no long interval of time we may therefore assume that it is coming."
