Livestock

MONTREAL, Nov. 22 (CP)—Receipts today on Montreal livestock markets were 220 cattle, 153 calves, 667 hogs and 150 sheep and lambs.

There was a good demand for all classes of live stock at steady prices, hogs showing the most strength.

Good steers made \$6 to \$6.25, with medium kinds up to \$5.75. Heifers ranged from \$3 to \$5. Good cows brought \$4 to \$4.50 and medium kinds \$3.50 to \$3.75 and common butchers \$2.75 to \$3.25. Canners and cutters made the bulk of the offerings, selling at \$2 to \$2.50. Common bulls were \$3 to \$3.50.

Calves were unchanged. Veals ranged from \$8 to \$10 with the bulk around \$9. Grassers were mostly \$4.

Good ewes and wethers were \$8 to \$8.25. Heavy lambs were cut \$1 per cwt. Culls and bucks were cut \$2 per cwt. Sheep were \$3 to \$3.75.

Hogs were stronger, selling at \$8.25 to \$8.50 for hogs fed and watered. Selects drew \$7 per hog premium with the usual cuts on off grades. Sows were \$6 to \$7. Hogs sold on rail grade brought \$11.60 cwt weight.

MINING

TORONTO, Nov. 22 (CP)—Bogged down in a mire of European alarms today, the Toronto stock market worked through a decidedly druggy session in which only 407,000 shares changed hands on a slow decline of prices.

With one exception it was the slowest full session since Sept. 6. Base metal and gold share indices declined .96 and .76 respectively while the industrial lost .52 and the western oils .24.

Some of the penny golds changed hands in considerable volume and most of them at price recessions.

Announcement of Waite-Amulet's mill-financing plan brought some selling in that issue and the price slipped 30 cents to 8.20. The close was 10 cents above the day's low. Bend Orelle dropped 7 cents. Hudson Bay and Noranda were steady.

The Little Long Lac district issues slumped under moderate covered to \$3 but Hard Rock finished 10 cents down and Little Long Lac lost 2. Wright-Hargreaves, selling ex-dividend, closed 15 cents off and losses of 5 to 10 cents were boarded by Conjarium, Mecassa, Pamour, Read-Authier and Toburn.

Royalite, Brown Davies, Home Oskala and Dalhousie were soft spots in the western oil list.
