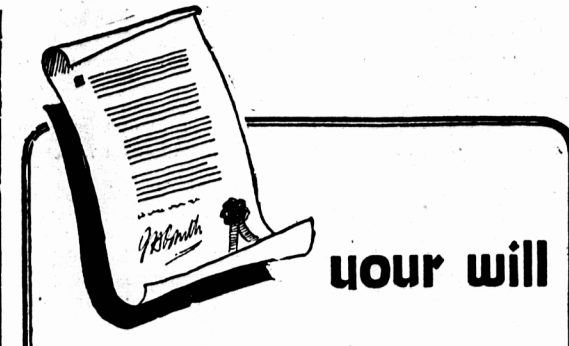

OTTAWA, Oct. 6 - (CP) - Dominion Government deposits increased \$10,803,000 to \$93,996,000 during the week ended Oct. 5, the Bank of Canada reported today. Chartered bank deposits decreased \$27,199,000 to \$562,422,000, while notes in circulation increased \$6,557,000 to \$1,296,225,000.
