Canada Must Choose (Continued from page 1) things. Yet the prophecies of Marx, when it venerates, have been disproved by the process of time. Wherever revolutionary methods have destroyed the fabric of society to place the state in supreme control, the standard of living has dropped, freedom has disappeared and the shadow of the secret police has darkened the threshold of every man's home.

When State is Master the People Defendless The "State," let us remember, is not always the embodiment of the people. It is sometimes a handful of bureaucrats who control the machinery of government. In fact, the more absolute the power of the State, the more remote it is from the people and the more indifferent it becomes to their needs.

Expansion Basis of Prosperity Expanding production is the basis of prosperity. The economic organization of yesterday was unable to achieve what we are demanding. State socialism can never achieve it, for socialism is rigid, centralized and coercive.

Bureaucracy Condemned It is surely agreed that the more we can decentralize administrative functions, the more efficient and less costly we shall be. There can hardly be a person within sound of my voice who has not had experience of the waste, confusion and waste of time which has followed the creation of the great bureaucracy of our day.

Piecemeal Politics vs. Socialism And now, on the one hand we witness piecemeal politics leading to a reaction on the other we are offered socialism. What the Progressive Conservative Party stands for is a position between the two extremes.

Do not tear off the jagged piece of leather when you have scuffed your shoes. Fasten it down with a little glue or colorless nail polish and after it is thoroughly dried it will never be noticed.

Concealed Power Dangerous This mad dream of a universe transformed into ordered perfection by a committee of very ordinary human beings is not only a pathetic delusion but it is also the possibility of a most unpleasant kind. If any group should ever be set a popular mandate to try and make it real, that group would shortly concentrate enormous power in its hands.

The Worst Barrier to Remove If the powers to regulate enterprise and the government are to be encouraged the orderly planning of production and employment and to prevent the economic stagnation in the interests of the public, then we shall have removed the worst barrier to progress.

Minority Cliques Also Dangerous We must not be deluded into believing that the officers of the State are always amenable to the people's will. We have been at war long enough to know that the power of the State is wielded all too often by a minority clique.

Bride the Strong, Lift the Weak The Progressive Conservative Party believes that the Government should bride the strong and see that their strength is turned to useful account.

National Socialism Means Dictatorship The word "Nazi" is an abbreviation of National Socialism. The political motives underlying its creation were different from and incomparably worse than those which inspired the formation of the Socialist Party in Canada.
