OTTAWA, July 31.—With the
first of next month important
changes will apply to the stamp
tax on telegrams and cables, che-
ques, promissory notes, bills of
exchange, overdrafts, express bills
of lading and stock transfers.
The rates in effect on August 1,
will be: Telegrams and cables, (other
than press messages) costing
fifteen cents or more. Che-
ques, bills of exchange, promis-
sory notes, express money or-
ders: Two cents for each fifty
dollars with a maximum tax of
two dollars.
Stock and bonds transfers.
Three cents per hundred dollars
of par value.
The above tax on bills of ex-
change and promissory notes ap-
plies when they are transferred
to a bank in such a manner as to
constitute the bank the holder, or
when they are delivered to a bank
or advances by way of overdraft,
the tax is two cents for every
fifty dollars of the maximum
amount advanced.
It is expected that an official
announcement of the taxes will
be issued shortly.
