Tenders must enclose the rates of ferris on the above severally, baggage, flour and meal at per one hundred pounds and grain and vegetables at per bushel.

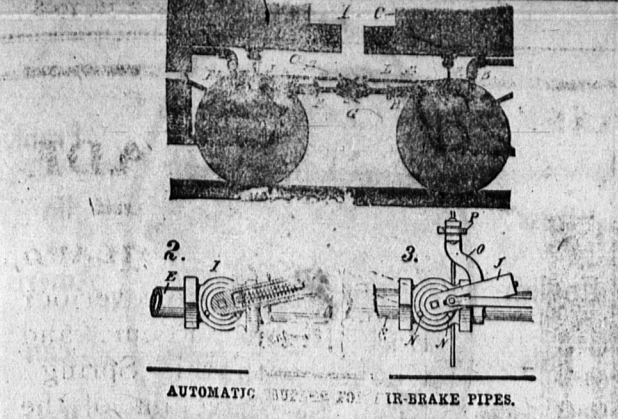

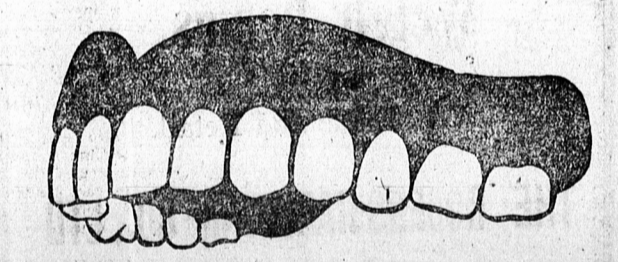
