Mrs. Moore reported that four dances had been held in February, with satisfactory financial results. These dances are to continue under the supervision of a men's committee.


Mrs. Cook, convener of Hall committee reported that the show, "Parkdale Revue" was to be presented in the near future and asked the members to assist the
