#### REAL LEATHER "STRETCHED" IN NEW HANDBAGS

NEW YORK - Leather is hard to come by these days and handbag manufacturers are using it sparingly and expensively. But they're also proving that a handbag does not have to be solid leather to be pretty. One designer who showed his most recent collection of women's pocket substitutes this week, has stretched his calf and suede with felt, suedea (a shiny wool broadcloth) and mock tortoise shell. And for dressier occasions has left it altogether to turn out gleaming bags in satin, cordura, faille, moiré, velvet, beaded embroidery and metallic brocade. Few of them are any cheaper than leather. They sell at retail from about \$25 to \$200, with one little satin envelope thrown in for the Christmas trade at a mere \$15. The all-calf daytime handbags sell in a \$50 range and the suedea are just under them, between \$25.00 and \$50. The most expensive are jeweled evening luxuries. The house manufactures in a number of favored shapes almost all of them precisely defined rather than bulky. Daytime calf and suede creations come large enough for the girl who carries most of her office with her and small enough for the dainty lady (if such there be) who needs only her handkerchief and carfare. One large bag has oval ends in calf matching fabric body and double straps in leather again. In the medium size range is a beautiful almost-square red calf envelope with zip-top closing and a curving outside pocket trimmed with a roll of leather.
