SHEEP AND DOGS.

Some weeks ago the question of sheep-raising was being discussed by the Island press, but of late the subject seems to have been dropped. The prices for both wool and lambs are now high and will likely continue so for some years. Prince Edward Island mutton has obtained an enviable reputation in the Western and American markets, and the quality can be still improved by proper feeding and breeding. At present prices, sheep are doubtless the most profitable animals that can be raised on the farm. It requires but little capital to start the business, and the farmer can easily find his own living. They require no expensive houses for shelter in winter and they are excellent wood-destroyers. There are only some of the points that can be mentioned in their favor.

It has been demonstrated that sheep can feed on the rag-wort without being injured and will eat it greedily when it is young and the pastures are green. In view of the fact that the eastern part of the Island and other places on the Island are now over-run with this poisonous weed, the question of sheep-raising becomes, I think, a vital one to the farmer. The industry has however a great drawback and we are in the large number of dogs that is kept on this Island. It is not always what the dogs usually desire but what they may desire that prevents many from going into the business of sheep-raising. The tender middle-man runs even a greater risk of loss by dogs than the farmer. To successfully deal in sheep and lambs it is necessary to call on the sheep and lambs at the shipping points and keep them over a few days or perhaps a few weeks, in pasture. During this time a flock of several hundred is liable to be destroyed or greatly injured by a night by dogs, and the owner of the sheep will be practically without redress, since because the chances are ten to one that he would not know whose dogs committed the depredation, and second, if he did know it might be difficult and would certainly be unpleasant to collect damages. No sensible man wishes to court a law suit in his business.

I handled some sheep and lambs last fall at prices which I think satisfied the sellers, but during the time I had them on hand I was in constant dread lest they might be destroyed in a single night by dogs.

I am now in a position to make a contract with large Western buyers for all the sheep and lambs I can send next fall, but I am afraid to enter into an agreement to supply any number for the reason above stated. In a word, it appears to me that it is now up to the farmers of Prince Edward Island to say whether they will raise sheep or dogs. I do not think they can raise both at the same time successfully. I therefore suggest that the farmers at the Island should consider this question and if they decide that the dogs should go, let them send the Legislature by resolution or otherwise to put a good stiff law on the statute. Their wishes in this matter would probably be carried out and the tax would doubtless have the effect of removing most of the worthless dogs now kept. Those living in towns or villages who keep dogs should, in addition to paying the tax, be obliged to have a collar on their animals on which the name of the owner could be stamped, and should always be obliged to keep them shut up at night.
