Two Chicago Murders Solved

CHICAGO, Oct. 1 — (AP) — The murders of two gambling bosses were listed as solved today with the assistance of something rarely obtained in major Chicago gang slayings, a detailed confession. Victims of the assassination were Martin (Sonny Boy) Quirk and Danny Stanton, who was No. 19 on the city's original list of 28 public enemies. Under arrest were two ex-convicts and gaming house employees, James Egan, 30, and Anthony De Lardo, 38. State's attorney Thomas J. Courtney said Egan had made a full statement concerning the killings and that De Lardo had admitted he was one of the two gunmen who felled Quirk with gunfire. The prosecutor reported the accounts of the prisoners covered this series of events: Stanton, who controlled a chain of 34 gambling houses on the south side, feared two competitors were growing too strong. He ordered Quirk, his lieutenant at the time, to "take charge" of them. Instead, Quirk conceived a double cross, and he and his henchmen slew Stanton in a saloon last May 5. The coup made Quirk overseer of the Stanton handbooks. But one of Quirk's chief aides conspired with Egan, De Lardo and three others to eliminate Quirk. They located Quirk at the Hawthorne race track, hurried back to town and laid an ambush outside his hotel. De Lardo and another gunman mortally wounded Quirk there Sept. 18.

Famed Newfoundland Sealing Vessel Sunk

ST. JOHN'S Nfld., Oct. 1 — (CP) — Newfoundland's breed of "wooden walls" all but became extinct today with the announcement of the sinking of the famed Terra Nova — second last remaining ship of the island colony's original fleet of 25 sealing vessels. Ranked as the finest, if not the largest, of the staunch wooden-steamers fleet that first challenged the ice in the sealing spring of 1863 and reigned supreme for more than 40 years, the Terra Nova was lost somewhere in "northern waters." The announcement did not state what present work the ship was engaged in nor just where she foundered, but said that her skipper, Captain Llewellyn Lush, and her crew were safe.
