SUMMARY OF PROCESSES INVOLVED IN THE USE OF FOOD

The stages in the use of food energy by living things are: (1) securing food; (2) taking food into the body (ingestion); (3) changing the food into liquids of such kinds that they can be taken into the blood (digestion); (4) taking the digested foods into the blood (absorption); (5) transporting the absorbed materials to every living cell in the body (circulation); (6) building new protoplasm (assimilation); and (7) using food materials to supply energy (oxidation).

ROBERT ASKE

Robert Aske was a young lawyer of good family who lived in Lincolnshire during the reign of Henry VIII. At the suppression of the monasteries, there was great discontent, especially in the north of England, and he was decided to make a "pilgrimage of grace" to London to protest against the abolition of the monasteries which had given not only religious comfort and instruction, but also help and schooling to the poor.

SIR JOHN WILLOUGHBY

At the close of the reign of the English King, Edward VI, an expedition set out to find for England a waterway to the East. It was commanded by Sir John Willoughby and Sir Richard Chancellor. Off the coast of Lapland, Chancellor's ship was separated from a storm from the two under Willoughby's command. He pushed on alone, however, along the northern coast of Russia.
