Unconditional Surrender

People ask what the Allies mean by "unconditional surrender." Perhaps one of the news items of United States' Office of War Information offers a clue.

Stockholm reports a manual issued by the German High Command which declares in a pep talk designed to halt the falling birthrate.

Such plans were being made in 1918 by the Prussian militarists long before Hitler aroused popular German enthusiasm for the present war.

Allied Plane Output

It is cheering to note that during May the American production of aircraft amounted to about 8,700 planes, most of them combat craft to support the big land invasion of Europe now under way.

In the text of its announcement the Board publishes some striking facts and figures relating to Allied and enemy aircraft production.

Meanwhile Japan's airplane factories are breaking all past records, and her rate of production continues to mount steadily.

Feeding Rome's Population

Now that Rome has been liberated, the United Nations are confronted with the problem of taking over the administration of the city and of providing work and food for the population.

They have no means of support, and how they fared under the Nazis it is not yet known, but with the Allies now in possession of the city it becomes their responsibility and it will be no small one from the food standpoint alone.
