MINUTES OF PRESBYTERY

(CONTINUED.)

The following Synod fund allocations were made: West River and Marshfield \$3 each; Richmond, Bay East, Tignish, Bonshaw, Mt. Stewart, Dundas, Murray Har. N., Murray Har. S., Wood Islands and Calledonia \$2; E. St. Peter's, Georgetown, Covehead, Orwell and Richmond Bay West, \$7 each; Cardigan, Alberton, \$8 each; Cavendish, Brookfield, Montague, Strathalbyn, Souris, Bloomfield, \$9 each; Clifton, Bede, ue, Valleyfield, \$10 each; Belfast, Kensington, Princetown, Summerside, St. James' and Zion, Charlottetown \$12 each; Mr. T. C. James reported on the McKenzie Fund as follows: Total receipts \$1785.35 expenditure \$15.00. On motion it was decided that \$85.35 be devoted to the church building fund at Georgetown, Demerara and the balance of \$200 carried forward. The report on McKenzie Fund was received and adopted, the committee thanked for their work and asked to publish their report in the Daily Press and in the Presbyterian Witness. The Home Mission report from Hampton congregations was presented and ordered to be transmitted to the Home Mission Board. The clerk read the report on statistics, the main features of which are as follows: Number of families within the bounds 3790; communicants 5900; stipend paid by congregations \$25,787; payments for all mission purposes \$14,277, raised by congregations for all purposes \$3774 the largest total since 1901; paid by church societies for missions and other purposes \$3,550; value of church property \$229,800. The report was received and adopted and the committee thanked for their work and asked to print their report in the press. Mr. A. B. McLeod presented the report on Church Life and Work, which was received and adopted and the committee thanked for their diligence, Presbytery then adjourned to meet in the next place at 2.30 o'clock p. m., of which public intimation was given, and this adjournment was closed with the benediction. Same place and at 2.30 p. m. Presbytery met pursuant to adjournment and was constituted. Mr. W. A. Mason moderator pro tempore. Sederunt ut supra. It was decided to apply for the following grants from the augmentation fund: Murray Harbor North \$12.50 for three months ending May 31st.

Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.

Any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may have a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along side his homestead. Price \$100 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of 3 years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and on 1/2 acre fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$500 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.00.
