Fresh Milk in Cubes

Philadelphia Public Ledger... In Holland milk is now put up and sold in solid form, being made into little cubes which are readily dissolved in tea, coffee or other fluids. The milk, after removal of the cream, is reduced by heat to dryness, then powdered and mixed with the cream, the material being pressed into blocks. These milk cubes have the advantage of preserving their freshness for a long time. They recommended for use in regions where milk is not easily to be had, and travellers may find it convenient to carry a supply of them.
