**Synopsis of Canadian North-West
HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.**

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 20, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section (40 acres, more or less).

Applications for entry must be made personally by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Sub-agency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may however, be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homestead holder.

The homestead holder is required to perform the homestead duties under one of the following plans:

(1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) A homestead holder may, if he so desire, permit the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent in the vicinity of his homestead. Joint ownership in land will not meet this requirement.

(3) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of homestead holder has permanent residence on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a homestead entered for by him in the vicinity of such homestead, he may perform the required residence duties by living with the father (or mother).

(4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than five miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowances crossed in the measurement.

(5) A homestead holder intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents or on farming land owned by himself must notify the Agent for the district of such intention.

Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of intention to apply for patent.

**GRAND BANKS
VESSELS AVERAGE
1, 500 QUINTALS**

Grand Bank Fleet Returned Home and Reports Big Catches.

NORTH SYDNEY, October 26.—Reports received here today from the fishing grounds, state all the Grand Bankers have arrived at Newfoundland, excepting the schooners Blanche Forsay, Orion, Minnie Ellen Dars. These vessels will likely leave in a day or two for the home port. The success of the bankers has been phenomenal, nearly all of them having full fares. It is estimated the average catch of the fleet will be about fifteen hundred of dry quintals. This is much in excess of the average catch of 1906.

Grape Growers in Niagara Belt Lost Heavily by Recent Frosts.

ST. CATHARINES, October 26.—Hundreds of tons of grapes in the Niagara fruit belt were ruined by frost last night, and grape growers have lost heavily. Ice to a thickness of half an inch formed, and it is understood that all grapes still uncut were destroyed. Growers made every effort to save the crop, many starting fires around their vineyards, but nothing seemed to avail. The minor frost a few nights ago cut off all the leaves, and there was absolutely no protection to the fruit.

End of Dr. Workman's Case at Theological College at Montreal.
