## LUMBER MILL AT TRURO BURNED

TRURO, N. S., Dec. 12. -- A serious fire in the fine lumber and building materials mill of Thomas A. Barnhill, Belmont, destroyed all the buildings, machinery, and much of the lumber lying near. The dwelling of John McKinnon, who was in Mr. Barnhill's employ, was also destroyed, but the occupants saved all their effects. The dwelling house was owned by Mr. Barnhill. A telephone message to Lovell Stewart, of Truro Fire Brigade, called urgently for help, as it was hoped some part of the mill and the house might be saved if assistance was quickly procured. There was some delay, however, in getting an engine and men, so that it was well on to half-past seven o'clock before Truro's chemical and men to operate it, were at the scene. By this time only a few lumber piles were left to be cared for, and some of these were ablaze. One T. C. R. flat car had the platform burned off.

Mr. Barnhill's loss is probably \$8,000, with insurance of \$1,300. This was partly on the machinery. No insurance on the dwelling house. Among the property destroyed was a gang saw mill, plan and matcher, gas and door and sash machines, pony and buzz-planer, sand paper and belt sanding apparatus, \$500 worth of new machinery had been in operation only a week.

There was great disappointment among the Moncton delegation when their application was refused. They put up a strong claim for recognition but the league decided to limit the teams to the present members. Wanderers and Crescents, Halifax, Ramblers, Amherst, New Glasgow, Windsor and Truro. Much disappointment was felt that the league did not admit the other Nova Scotia teams that applied. Unless another league is formed, all the teams outside of the six in the Provincial league will be placed under a great disadvantage.
