PRINCE DE SAGAN WSA IN HALIFAX

Suitor for Hand of Anna Gould; Landed There From Victorian.

MONTREAL, March 25.—Prince Helie De Sagan who fought a fist fight in the gutter in Paris with Count Boni De Castellane, passed through here yesterday on his way to join the Gould family in New York, where Anna Gould, the divorced wife of Count Boni, has just arrived from France. He came on the steamer Victorian from Liverpool to Halifax under the name of H. Thomas and registered at the Windsor.

When he came to pass the United States Immigration officials he had to give his real name and though he stormed wildly he had to pay up his two dollar poll tax.

NEW YORK, March 25.—Prince Helie De Sagan, who is a suitor for the hand of Mme. Anna Gould, is believed to have arrived in New York within a few days with the object of renewing his attractions to the American heiress. The man who is believed to be Prince Helie registered at a New York hotel as W. H. Thompson, but gave no address. He reached New York a few days after Mme. Gould and dined with Mme. Gould last evening at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Typer Morse. The visit of Prince De Sagan here at this time was unexpected, at least by those who know something of the affairs of the Prince and of Mme. Gould. She left Paris to spend some time in this country, away from the cares that had weighed upon her in the French capital.

ROMANCE OF THE EARL OF DUDLEY

Lately Appointed Governor General of Australia

LONDON, March 25.—The career of the Earl of Dudley is filled with romance. When a young man he married a pretty girl, who trimmed hats in her mother's millinery establishment in London. He has developed qualities which the friends of his youth did not suspect him of possessing. He has risen steadily and in the course of his rule and that of the countess in Ireland, he won the reputation of being the only Viceroy of Ireland who ever caused the Irish people to like him.

The young man, on coming of age, was the inheritor of vast estates, the high steward at Kidderminster, captain in the Worcestershire yeomanry, master of Whitley court. He was a graduate of Eton. He was only 18 years of age when he came into the title of second Earl of Dudley.

In paying court to Rachel Gurney, the Earl turned his back on one of the daughters of the Prince of Wales with whom his mother had arranged for an alliance for him. He married the modiste in Trinity church, London, in 1891, in the presence of all the aristocracy.

Miss Gurney's parentage was said to be royal on one side. Her mother was one of a long line of reigning beauties of which Langtry was one of the most famous. The young woman was of exquisite face and figure, accomplished and womanly. She had been brought up in the family of the Duchess of Bedford, but was never presented at court until after the Earl married her.

When in recognition of his progress in politics the government sent the Earl and his Countess to be Viceroy and Vicereine of Ireland, the Earl set about working for Ireland's good. His Countess helped him admirably. They toured Ireland in an automobile, living among the peasants and making friends wherever they went. "He is the most popular Viceroy Ireland ever had," said one of the Nationalist members.

BILL TO AMEND SHIPPING ACT

Extending Limits of Coasting Waters, Abolition-Pilotage Advocated

OTTAWA, March 25.—The principal cigar manufacturer of Canada met Hon. Mr. Templeman and Hon. Mr. Fielding a few days ago and asked for a change in duties. They asked that the duty be made \$1 instead of \$2 per thousand as at present for domestic cigars; that the specific custom duty be increased on imported cigars from 3 to 4 cents per pound without charging the ad valorem rate; that the Government be requested to tax all Canadian leaf offered for sale five cents per pound. They think 28 cents per pound duty on unstripped, and 42 cents on stripped tobacco is too wide a margin, and advise a rate of 35 cents a pound on stripped.

The Bill to amend the Shipping Act, introduced by A. H. Maclean, was heard before a special committee this morning. Two witnesses were called and examined by Mr. Maclean and the members of the committee. The witnesses were R. C. Elkins and W. Smith of St. John. Both witnesses gave unqualified statements as to the advisability of extending the southern limits of the coasting waters as far as River La Plata. They both were equalled strong as to increasing the tonnage of vessels in the coasting trade, and for which no certificated master should be required. They favored a seven hundred ton limit, as in the United States. They both approved of the part of the Bill dispensing with pilotage in the case of vessels entering a harbor for refuge. Mr. Smith expressed himself strongly in favor of the total abandonment of compulsory pilotage on the Atlantic Coast, excepting the River St. Lawrence. The Committee will meet again tomorrow.

GREAT BRITAIN IS ALL RIGHT

Congressman Landis Recalls Tribute of President McKinley.

NEW YORK, March 25.—Congressman Landis, of Indiana, one of the speakers at the dinner of the Beta Theta Phi Club, at the Hotel Astor, Saturday night, said:

"In my mind the best fruit of the Spanish-American War was the cementing of friendship between the United States and Great Britain. That friendship protects the United States from war with Japan or any other country, but Japan does not want to go to war with us.

"I remember a conference in the White House in the beginning of that war, which had been assembled to consider the possibility of European nations assisting to make the United States keep hands off Cuba and Spanish affairs generally. I brought to the President a copy of a poem which had been written by Alfred Austin and was evidently inspired by his royal master. President McKinley looked up with relief as he said: 'Great Britain is all right.' That was the message from Great Britain to the United States for all time."

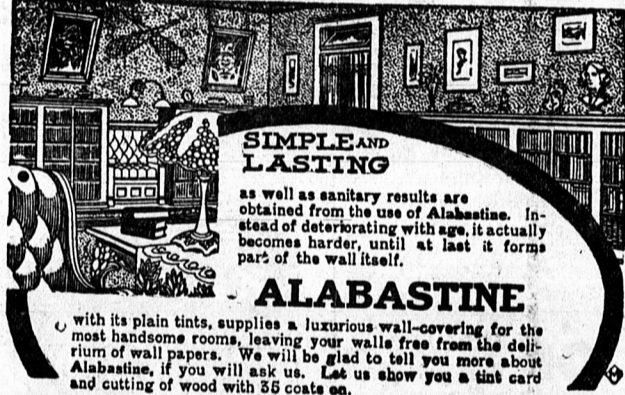
