REPAIRING THE MONEY PALACE OF THE WORLD.

An item in the news of the day states that the work of repairing the foundations of the bank of England, which had begun to sink, is now well under way. The work involves the cutting away of the original piles on which the buildings have rested for nearly two centuries, but it is significant of English love of stability and the accustomed order of things that no one has even suggested the tearing down of the buildings and erecting a modern structure in their place.

The buildings of the bank of England in their completed state date back only to 1786, which is comparatively modern for London. Writers of a century ago dilated upon the wonders and beauties of a group of buildings which today impress the visitor as being rather more suggestive of a prison than of the money palace of the world's financial center for nearly two centuries. Classic Greek and Roman suggestions abound in it—here a hint of the Propylaea of Athens, with fluted and ornamented Corinthian and massive Doric columns, and there suggestions of the temple of Venus or of the Sibyl at Delphi. The arch of Constantine, and a rotunda which has looked down upon the money kings of Threadneedle and Lombard streets for generations. The whole, as a writer in 1834 remarked, conveys "an impression of opulence and security." Its thick walls of solid stone and brick and its spacious underground vaults would probably bid defiance to a conflagration that might sweep over the rest of London. The buildings themselves stand detached and cover more than three acres of ground, and including the nine open courts, about eight acres, in the heart of London.
