BERLIN, Oct. 13. — A. Holland Forbes and Augustus C. Post, the two American aeronauts who had such a narrow escape from death when their balloon, the Conqueror, burst in the air at an altitude of 4,000 feet, have completely recovered this morning from the effects of their thrilling experience.

Mr. Forbes drove out this morning and examined what was left of the balloon prior to having it packed for transportation back to New York, whither it will be shipped tomorrow. The envelope is torn into five pieces and there are also in many holes as a result of its contact with roofs.

ACCIDENTS TO RIVER BOATS

ST. JOHN, Oct. 13. — Today was a day of mishaps for river boats. The Hampton, on her down river trip this morning had one of her three rudders broken. The accident was caused by the low water, the rudders striking bottom. She will have repairs made here.

GERMAN EXPERTS ON TUBERCULOSIS

MONTREAL, October 13. — Two celebrated German scientists, Professor Ehrlich and Dr. Freund, who came from Germany to attend the International Tuberculosis Congress at Washington, arrived in the city today and are this afternoon addressing the committee of the Berman Rest institution for the treatment of tuberculosis in the Laurentian Mountains, on the latest methods of treatment of the disease in Germany. Dr. Freund is the leader of the German movement in the tuberculosis fight and has been rewarded by the Kaiser. Dr. Freund has also taken a conspicuous part in the war being waged in Germany on the white plague. Their visit is attracting much attention in medical circles and the visitors were entertained at luncheon at the Mount Royal club, at which a meeting took place at the art gallery, presided over by Dr. Roddick.
