Two or three other New Brunswick fisheries also showed catch reduction but, on the other hand, the pollock landings went up 100 per cent and more.

Two fish—cod and herring—made up all save a small part of Quebec's landings of 4,800,000 pounds, with cod much the bigger contributor.

LONDON (CP)—Britain, long proud of her reputation for law and order, is experiencing an extensive crime wave. There has been a 98 per cent increase in shopbreaking since 1938, a 195 per cent increase in robberies and assault and 165 per cent more larcenies from dwelling houses.
