METHODISTS CUT DELEGATES

General Conference of Methodist Episcopal Church Reduced One-Third.

BALTIMORE, Md., May 18—Practically all the delegates to the Methodist-Episcopal general convention today made the trip to the national capital and listened to the address of President Roosevelt. The committee on the state of the church will, it is understood, ask the conference to reduce the number of delegates by one-third, or perhaps one-half, believing that the general conference as at present constituted is too unwieldy and that the business coming before it would be disposed of more expeditiously, and in every way better, if the number of delegates were very much smaller. The matter will likely come before the conference during next week. Indications point to the contraction being approved. Chicago representatives are making a strenuous effort to have the eastern and western branches of the Book Concern consolidated and removed to suburbs of their city. It is proposed, in the event of the consolidation and removal, to build a new and the great printing centre of Methodism.

KURDS ARE BENT ON PILLAGING

Villages Attacked and Villagers Who Resisted Killed

ST. PETERSBURG, May 18—Serious news has been received from Urumia, a Persian town near the Russian border, and from Salmas.

Two thousand Kurds of the Zersa Mamash and Mergevire tribes are making an expedition of pillage and murder, burning villages, destroying telegraphs, killing and plundering as they go.

Fourteen villages have been attacked. In some cases the villagers have offered armed resistance, and there has been heavy fighting, with a large number killed. In other villages the inhabitants fled as the Kurds approached into the mountains. Many—especially the women—were captured by the Kurds and carried off into captivity. A grim tragedy was enacted in the village of Dutmatchin, where a great number of the inhabitants took refuge in a mosque. The Kurds set fire to the building, and all within it perished in the flames. Two infantry battalions, a battery of quick-firers and a squadron of Cossacks have been dispatched to the frontier from Tiflis.

RESCUE FROM WRECKED VESSEL

Watched by Hundreds—Life Boat Saves Crew Spite of Seas

NEW YORK, May 18—Hundreds of dwellers along the beach witnessed the rescue by life savers of the captain and crew of four men of the schooner Wm. McGee, sighted off Sea Island City, N. J., water-logged and flying signals of distress. The sea was so rough that the life savers at Sea Island were for a time unable to launch their boat. Later they were able to get out to the disabled craft and save those on board. The McGee, Captain Fearsel, was bound from West Point, Va., for New York. She went to pieces at Camden Inlet. She hailed from New York and was built in Maryland in 1865.

YACHTS READY FOR OCEAN RACE

BOSTON, May 18—Conditions under which the coming ocean yacht race from Marble Head to Bermuda will be held were issued today, although the start will not take place until June 3. The yachts will be sent off in four classes with a time allowance for the full distance, 675 nautical miles. The start will be off Marble Head and finish off St. David's Head, Bermuda. There are no restrictions as to the number of the crew or as to the character of the crew or to sails. The race is held under the joint auspices of the Corinthian Yacht Club of Marble Head and the Royal Bermuda Yacht Club of Bermuda.
