Good progress was made by the Committee yesterday in securing subscriptions to the Monument Fund, as will be seen by reference to the list printed in another column. The sums pledged already pass the thousand dollar mark and the number of leading citizens who are hoped to contribute liberally is by no means exhausted. The list so far is creditable to the subscribers and also to the influential and energetic committee who have the matter in hand.

The object is one which ought to commend itself, and which does commend itself strongly to the people at large. It is due to the brave men of the Contingent, dead and living, who risked so much and suffered so much that they and the war in which they bore a brave part should have a memorial in our midst. It is to be observed also that this loyal British Province and City have as yet no public monument of any kind expressing the imperial idea. The war in South Africa was a distinctly Empire-building event, and on that account, and especially because Canadians and our own Island men took part therein it seems peculiarly fitting that we should now join together to signalise it in a worthy manner.

In our hearts we honor the men who volunteered so promptly and who won such distinction for the Island and for Canada. We are proud of our position as a Dominion, only second in importance to one of the three Kingdoms in the great British Empire. We hope and trust that the bond which binds the Empire together may endure for ages to come, and we know that the blood of Briton, Celt, Canadian and Australian shed together in a righteous cause in South Africa has made that bond stronger than ever before. All these considerations should prompt us to build the Monument and make it express our appreciation of valor, patriotism and that great imperial idea to which reference has been made.

The monument will besides afford a worthy object lesson to future generations and will be an ornament to our City and Province. We repeat that we think the Provincial Government might fairly donate one thousand dollars for such an object and our City Council one half that sum. Then we might fairly hope and expect that individual subscriptions large and small throughout the City and Province would swell the amount to a grand total of five thousand dollars. This sum should be realised if possible and will not be too much for the great and worthy object in view.

Lord Strathcona has told the public that he is not going back to London as High Commissioner, and a very probable report states that Sir Richard Cartwright will succeed him in that important office. We believe that this arrangement will be quite satisfactory both to the people of Canada and of the Mother Country. Sir Richard is one of the ablest and most eminent men of his party. He sat in the old Parliament of Canada from 1863 till the union of 1867 and has since sat continuously in the House of Commons. He held the important position of Finance Minister in the Mackenzie Cabinet, was long the chief financial critic of the Liberal Opposition and has since been Minister of Trade and Commerce in the Laurier Cabinet. His long and distinguished service, his high character, his Trinity College education, his courtly manners and considerable private fortune are all elements of fitness for the position with which his name is now connected.
