ANY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the Northwest Provinces, excepting 8 and 24, not reserved for the benefit of any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 21 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

SEALED TENDERS, addressed to the undersigned, marked on the envelope "Tenders for Construction" will be received at the office of the Commissioners of the Transcontinental Railway at Ottawa, until twelve o'clock noon on Monday the 12th day of March, 1906, for the work required for the construction in accordance with the plans, profiles and specifications of said Commissioners, for the following sections of the Transcontinental Railway, to be completed on or before the first day of September, 1907, viz:—

(1) District "A" From a point designated on the plans of the said Commissioners at or near the City of Winnipeg, to a point known as Peninsula Crossing, near the junction point of the Fort William branch of the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway, a distance of about 245 miles, in District "A" of the said Commissioners.

(2) District "B" From a point designated on the plans of the said Commissioners at the north end of the Quebec bridge and Railway Company's bridge in the vicinity of the City of Quebec, to a point near La Tuque, a distance of about 145 miles, in District "B" of the said Commissioners.

(3) A steel viaduct about 3,000 feet long across the Cap Rouge Valley, in said District "B", in the vicinity of the City of Quebec, the work to be performed in accordance with the general specifications of the said Commissioners, for the construction of said viaduct, and the general specifications for steel bridges and viaducts of the Department of Railways and Canada, 1904.

Plans, profiles and specifications may be seen in the office of the Chief Engineer of the said Commissioners at Ottawa, also in the office of the District Engineer in charge of the work in the section of District "A" and for the section of District "B" in the office of the District Engineer at Quebec.

Persons tendering are notified that tenders will not be considered unless made in duplicate, and one of the limited forms supplied by the Commissioners.

Tenders must be submitted for the work in each District.

Tenders shall not be in any way entitled to rely upon the classification or any other information given by any person on behalf of the Commissioners, and no tender shall be executed, and fully inform themselves as to the quantity and quality of materials and character of workmanship required, and are understood to accept and agree to be bound by the terms and conditions contained in the form of contract, specifications, &c., annexed to the form of tender.

Each tender must be signed and sealed by all the parties to the tender and witnessed and accompanied by a cheque or other document payable to the Commissioners of the Transcontinental Railway, in the sum of \$100,000, for District "A", and two hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$250,000) for District "B", in full of the tender, and the tenderer is notified that the tenderer is not to be bound by the acceptance of the tender until the acceptance of the tender is confirmed by the Commissioners, and in any case of refusal or failure on the part of the party whose tender is accepted to complete and execute a contract with the said Commissioners, it is to be understood that the tenderer is liable for the amount of the tender, and in the event of a dispute arising as to what is the current or a fair and reasonable rate, it shall be determined by the Commissioners, whose decision shall be final.

This agreement, subject to the regulations now in force, or which may at any time hereafter be in force, during the construction of the works hereby contracted for, made under the authority of the Department of Labour, and which shall be applicable to such works.

The contractor shall in connection with the whole of the said work, as far as practicable, use only material, machinery, plant, supplies and building stock manufactured or produced in Canada, provided the same can be obtained as cheaply and upon as good terms in Canada as elsewhere, having regard to quality and price.

The contractor shall conform to the Fire Regulations adopted by the Commissioners, and also to the Laws and Regulations respecting fire in the different Provinces wherein the work is being performed.

The right is reserved to reject any or all tenders.

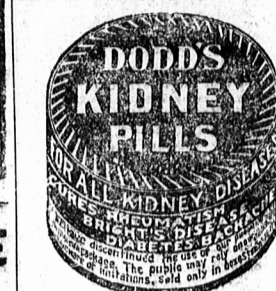

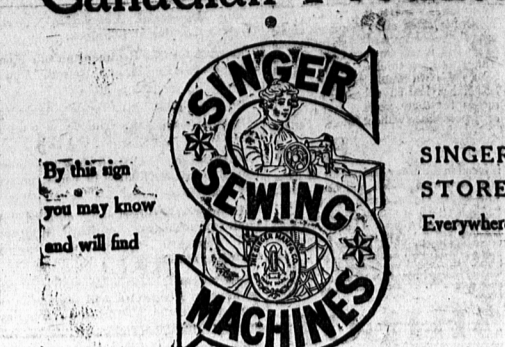
