SHEDIAC IS ADVANCING

Now Installing A System of Water-Works

Many Large Brick Buildings in Course of Erection and Other Signs of Progress.

(From our Summerside Correspondent)
A visit to the little town of Shediac, just across the water, at the present time gives one the impression that the people there are enterprising and progressive to say the least, sufficiently so to make a Summerside man feel ashamed. With a population of only about 1,700 souls Shediac only in October last February and with only \$1,400 in the treasury, is already installing a system of water-works. No assessments have as yet been levied, the present small revenue having been obtained through police court fines and sundry licenses.

The water-works system being put in is estimated to cost about \$25,000. The work is divided into three contracts. While the town is putting in the reservoir and pumping station, the pumping engine and all fixtures connected therewith are contracted for by The John McDougall Caledonia Co. of Montreal. The elevated tank, or stand pipe is being placed by The Ontario Wind Engine Co. of Toronto; while The Maritime Contracting and Mining Co. have the contract for laying the pipes. T. A. McLean of Charlottetown, one of the company, superintending the work.

The water will be procured from a well 280 ft deep and will be pumped to the reservoir, holding 200,000 gallons and also to the stand pipe, 120 ft. high in the upper part of the town which will hold 80,000 gallons. There will be about a mile and a half of pipe laid throughout the town with 18 fire hydrants.

The work is now well underway, and in a short time Shediac will be counted among the pure water towns of the Maritime provinces. And not only will the people of Shediac have fit water to drink, but will have fire protection which will save its citizens on insurance rates and secure for the residents that safety from fire which accompanies all such systems. The fire which swept the business portion of Shediac in October 1902 has awakened its people to the fact that an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure; and while they have the 2s with which to cure, they are guarding themselves well against any possible future attacks.

Besides providing themselves with sufficient water supply, the business men of Shediac realizing the worth of something like fire-proof buildings, are erecting magnificent brick and stone structures which would do credit to a large city.

The portion of the town which a year ago was covered with heaps of ashes is now greatly improved and brightened by a row of buildings which must be a source of pride to its loyal citizens.

The new business blocks now in course of construction and most of which are about completed comprise the following:—

The Comeau Brick Block is 90 x 80 ft., three stories, occupancy three stores and the Peoples Bank of Halifax, cost about \$16,000.

The Poirier Block, brick, is 72 x 85 ft.,
