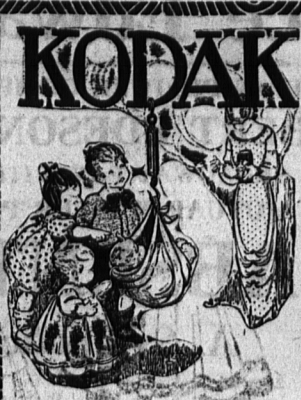

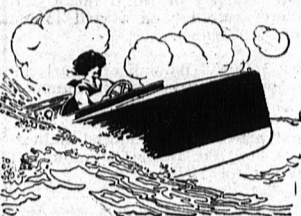

THE DAIRY MARKETS.—The Canadian Countryman of May 20th which has just come to hand in speaking of Dairy Produce in Toronto says:—"Fresh creamery prints are down one cent per lb. There is a feeling in the trade that prices have pretty well touched bottom, however, as considerable quantities of milk have been diverted from the butter to the cheese factories, and consequently dealers are expecting less butter and more cheese. Prices for cheese continue high at country points, sales being reported at 19 1/2 and 19 5/16 F. O. B. It is thought the market will not break—if it does break—to any great extent before the latter part of the month or the beginning of June." The Montreal Gazette of May 20th states that on Friday's Auction butter sold 1/2 to 3/4 cent higher and Cheese brought 1/2 to 3/4 cent more and gives the price of finest creamery at 29 to 29 1/2 and cheese at 19 1/2 to 19 5/16 per lb. In speaking of the horse situation, the Countryman says: Demand for commercial horses in Toronto continues active. The presence of buyers from various points has stiffened prices from \$5 to \$10. For good work and draught horses \$170 to \$200 each as paid. A load of good farm animals went to Brandon

at \$160. Loads were also shipped to Montreal and Quebec.

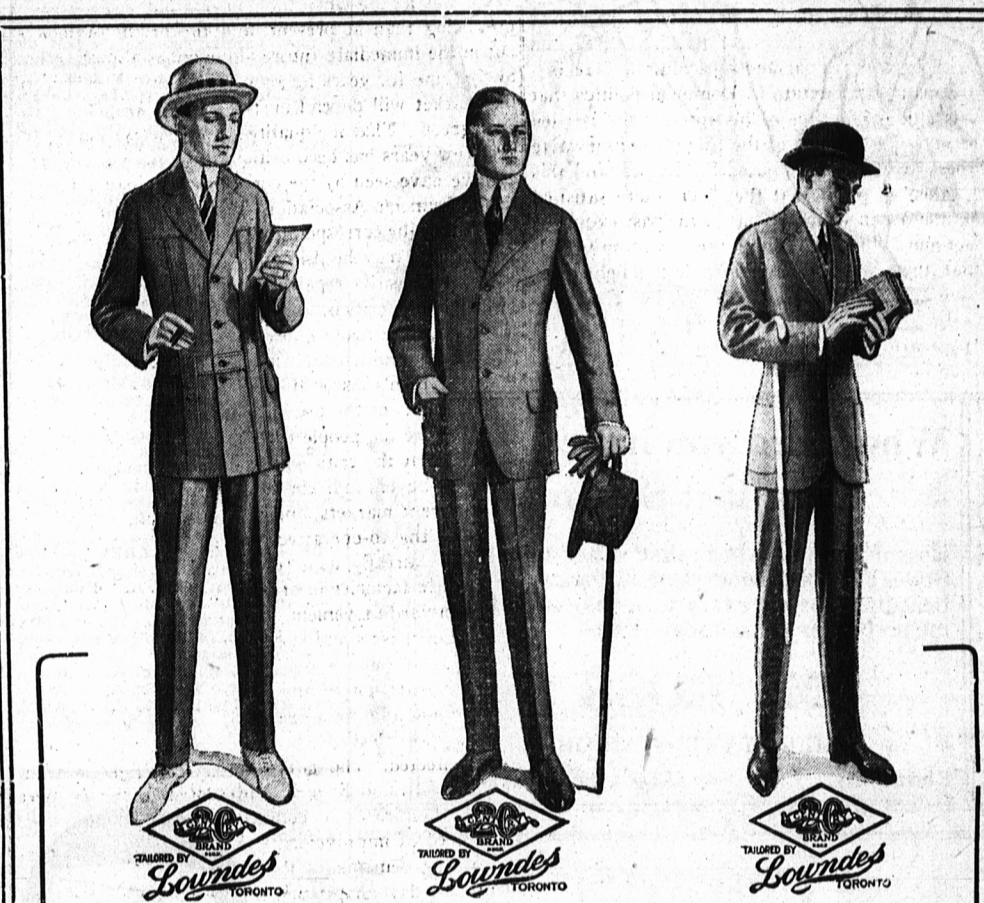
