### NO MIXED CHOIRS SAYS OTTAWA ARCHBISHOP

OTTAWA, March 14.—There will be no mixed choirs allowed at Catholic services notwithstanding certain rumors to the contrary, was the statement made at the Archbishop's Palace Sunday. It was pointed out that when the new law of the church went into force about two years ago some inquiries were addressed to Rome by some of the churches in the United States, and recently a reply was received. This was to the effect that mixed choirs would not be permitted at the liturgical services in America any more than in any other part of the world. Congregational singing will be allowed, and women may sing alone at the low masses and sodality meetings.

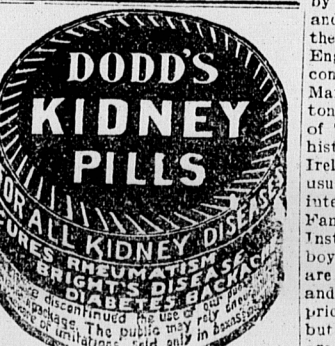
