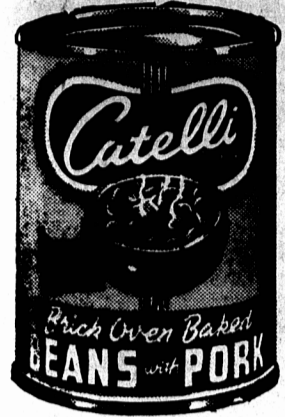

Q. How can I take proper care of leather furniture?

A. To clean leather furniture, add a little vinegar to warm water and then wipe dry. Restore the polish with two tablespoons of turpentine mixed with whites of two eggs, beaten slightly but not stiffly.

MODEST BUDGET AFFORDS FURS The woman on a modest budget is in the \$195-\$300-a-year fur coat class, a furrier said.

For the woman with a moderate budget the fur expert placed muskrat back at the top of the list of best wearing coats; Persian lamb coats which can be bought for between \$650 and \$900 he also figured were excellent.

When choosing a fur coat make sure the fur is lustrous and uniform throughout the garment. Examine particularly the skins used under the arms, the under part of the sleeves, making sure these parts are not made of inferior skins.

When possible examine the leather side of the coat. A good skin has leather that is soft and supple but firm and strong. Old skins may be harsh and brittle.

FLOOR COVERING OF VARIED SORTS Planning to replace worn-out linoleum in your home this spring?

The vinyl coverings and "inlaid" linoleum are the most expensive and the longest wearing. They are recommended for floors subjected to heavy traffic, i.e., kitchens, reception rooms, porches.

"Inlaid" linoleum derives its resilient surface from a linseed oil base mixture which is mounted on a saturated felt or burlap backing. There are three grades of inlaid linoleum—light, standard and heavy.

Most vinyl resin coverings are laminated to waterproof felt backings. This insures a tight seal between covering and floor. This type of covering is non-porous and requires no waxing. It has high abrasion resistance.

CHANGING SELF EXCELLENT IDEA "Everything wrong with the pattern of my marriage is a result of mistakes I made in the first year or two.

But she is wrong in that last statement, declares a woman observer. A woman can change the pattern of her marriage any time. And a really wise woman is forever changing it.

No young and inexperienced wife knows enough in her first year of marriage to establish a permanent way of living. She is bound to make plenty of mistakes. But every year of living ought to show her what those mistakes are, and little by little she should gain the insight to enable her to correct them.

The secret of how to do that, of course, is that a woman must change herself instead of trying to change her husband. If she succeeds in changing her own actions in a situation that doesn't suit her and is consistent in playing her new role, her husband is bound to change in his own attitude and reactions.

Take as an example the woman who is a whatever-you-say-dear, kind of wife, catering to her husband's every wish. All she has to do to change the pattern is to change herself. This holds true in other situations. To change an unsatisfactory marriage pattern a wife changes herself — and the pattern takes on a new shape.

Child's Behavior Can Be Traced In Brain Waves

IOWA CITY, IOWA, June — (AP) — Brain waves are giving clues as to why some children and adults often are in social and legal hot water.

The waves are electrical impulses recorded from the brain. Certain abnormal waves are found with greater frequency in children and adults with certain personality disorders, studies here show.

pathic personality and behavior disorders in children being studied at the psychopathic hospital and State University of the Iowa College of Medicine. Study of the brain waves of parents of the children in trouble indicates that the patterns often are inherited. If one or both parents had an abnormal pattern, the chances were that their offspring would have a similar one.

Traced To Childhood

Sometimes the unusual brain waves could be traced to illness or injuries of early childhood, although the child appeared to have recovered. The younger the child at the time, and the more severe the illness or injury, the more likely he was to show the abnormal brain waves and personality problems.

In another phase of the study, characteristic traits of parents and children are being compared through personality tests. Many parents were found to be emotionally immature, having traits similar to those of the patients. The early lives of these patients,

It was found, almost always were implicated by disturbing environments, such as broken homes, unstable parents, deaths, desertion and alcoholism. These are being studied in relation to personality and behavior.
