DON CARLOS IS IN SPAIN.

MADRID, Nov. 2.—Don Carlos, the Spanish pretender, is reported to have arrived in Catalonia, in Northeastern Spain. His agents are active in all parts of the country. The government has ordered gunboats to patrol the coast, to prevent the landing of munitions, and although, the authorities claim to have reassuring news, an army of police is active in forestalling attempts at insurrection.

ISLANDS OUT OF PLACE.

Revelations of a long cruise in the South Seas—Steering by Chart Dangerous.

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 3.—Discoveries of great value are reported by the United States fish commission ship Albatross which has just returned from a fourteen month cruise in the south seas and in Japanese and Alaskan waters. The officers of the vessel state that nearly all of the South Sea Islands are mischarted anywhere from two to a dozen miles, making steering by chart extremely dangerous. The exceptions are Fiji group owned by Great Britain and the Tahiti group owned by France. New and accurate sailing directions for use among the islands have been prepared.

A world's record for deep sea net dragging was made about 30 miles east of the Tonga group of islands in latitude 20 degrees south; specimens of marine life were brought up from a depth of 1200 fathoms, or nearly five miles.
