BRITISH AND BOERS TO UNITE

Colonial Secretary Smutz Speaking At Johannesburg Counsels Them To Agree

JOHANNESBURG, Feb. 10.—Mr. Smutz, Colonial secretary, speaking at the Parliamentary Debating Society's dinner, declared that Cecil Rhodes and Paul Kruger were the dominating personalities in South African history. They had laid the spoor which would be followed for centuries.

He spoke in glowing terms of heroic actions by British and Dutch in South Africa, which, he said, were the finest inheritance of the country. The people were determined not to look to the ghost of racialism and sectionalism, but would appeal to what was best in each other.

When the question of the reorganization of the volunteers was before him, involving the elimination of names glorious in the history of the Transvaal, he refused to allow the disappearance of the Imperial Light Horse. "That name," he continued, "has a right to survive in the history of the Transvaal."

Mr. Smutz added that the Boers and British must unite. They would unite. Sir Percy Fitzpatrick made a speech in which he said that the spirit which pervaded the Transvaal Parliament during the last session was one of praiseworthy dignity and restraint. The country members, he declared, would have been an ornament to any legislature in the world.

Synopsis of Canadian Homestead Regulations

ANY even numbered section of 160 acres in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 20, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person whose sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section 160 acres, more or less.

Applications for entry must be made personally by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Subagency for the district which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may ever be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father or mother, son, sister, brother or sister of any intending homesteader. The homesteader is required to perform the homestead duties under one of the following plans:

(1) At least six months residence and cultivation of the land in each year three years.

(2) A homesteader may, if he so desire, perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in vicinity of his homestead. Joint ownership of land will not meet this requirement.

(3) If the father or mother, if neither is deceased, of homesteader has deposited an affidavit on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon homestead entered for by him in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon homestead entered for by him in the vicinity of the homestead, he may perform his residence duties by living with the father or mother.

(4) This term "vicinity" in the preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning more than nine miles in a direct line, or the width of road allowance cross in the measurement.

(5) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with above while living with parents and on farming land owned by himself must notify Agent for the district of such intention. Six months' notice in writing must be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of attention to apply form.
