Critical Of Latest "March Of Time" Air Marshal "Billy" Bishop Invested

LONDON, Nov. 23 — (CP — Reuters) — A demand that the latest "March of Time" picture, "Strategy of Liberation," should be "recalled and re-edited," is made today in an editorial in "World's Press News," a trade journal of the British press.

Writing what it calls the film's "extreme partiality to the Stars and Stripes," the Journal says it "unfairly suppressed and plays down the parts performed by the British, Canadian and French forces in a theme which purports to tell the tale of history from Normandy to Brussels."

OTTAWA, Nov. 23 — (CP) — Air Marshal W. A. (Billy) Bishop, who retired from the R. C. A. F. as director of recruiting in September was invested with the insignia of a companion (military division) of the most honorable Order of the Bath at a private investiture at Government House today.

Air Marshal Bishop, who already holds the V. C., D. S. P., and bar M. C., and D. F. C., was awarded the C. B. in the King's birthday honors list earlier this year.

The investiture was made by the Earl of Athlone, governor-general. Mrs. Bishop was present.
