THE MOVEMENT FOR TARIFF REDUCTION.

The Montreal Gazette intimates that Sir Wilfrid Laurier artfully encouraged the expression of free trade sentiments among the farmers of the Northwest, although why he should have done so is not made clear.

The Gazette finds that the Liberal leaders, when they became vested with responsibility and had carefully studied the question, became convinced that the well-being of the country demanded the continuance of protection. Hence there was left in the schedules so much protection that, aided by the growth of population and wealth and increasing demand for merchandise, manufacturers have generally found the period profitable.

When Campbellton was burned it was a license town. After the fire the Provincial Government cancelled the licenses. Almost everybody who considers the case concludes that this was the right thing to do.

But these men who had paid for their license might object, and did object. They were forced to stop selling, however. It was felt that neither life, property nor morals would be quite so safe if liquor selling were allowed as if it were stopped.

And the Dominion Government forbids the sale of liquor all along the line of the Transcontinental Railway construction, and employs police magistrates and peace officers to enforce the prohibition.

But if prohibition is no good, why this prohibition? The navvies working to build the railway surely have as much right to drink and get drunk as have the people of any other calling or station in life.

Here in Prince Edward Island we have reached the conclusion that if selling liquor to Indians is bad it is also bad to have it sold to white men; that if the trade is dangerous to men who build railways it cannot be good for workers in other industries and that if it is bad for a town that has suffered from fire, it can hardly be good for a town that has not been thus afflicted.

Very probably there has been no weakening in that regard among the protected manufacturers and other beneficiaries of the tariff, but there has been a great strengthening of the sentiment against high protection in both the east and the west of Canada within the past few years, and along with this there are such indications of a like feeling in the United States as give assurance of a continental movement toward tariff reduction.

In the tariff revisions of 1897 and 1907 the manufacturers were able to dominate the situation largely because the great mass of consumers were occupied with other issues and had not been aroused to look after their own interests.

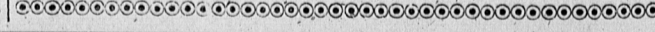
