**Trains Being Derailed In India**

(Associated Press) CALCUTTA, Dec. 20.—A passenger train was derailed near Asansol early today owing, officials said, to "malicious" removal of plates joining the rails together. No one was injured.

It was the second time within a week that a passenger train in India, was derailed. The Dinapur express had just left a wayside station and was about to travel through open country, proceeding slowly, when the entire train, consisting of an engine and nine cars, toppled on its side.

One person was killed and a number injured when the other train was derailed at Titvala Thursday. That derailment was caused, it was thought, by the rails having been tampered with.

**28 Lives Lost In Sea Tragedy**

(Associated Press) LONDON, Dec. 18.—Twenty-eight persons were believed to have lost their lives in three sea tragedies resulting from the violent gales that swept the North Sea and surrounding areas today. Meanwhile London and large parts of England suffered from cold, raw fog or frost which tied up traffic and generally delayed railway movement. One motorist was killed in a collision near Gloucester, and minor accidents were numerous.

**Telephones**

OTTAWA, Ont., Dec. 20. (By the Canadian Press)—The number of telephones in use in Canada at Dec. 31, 1930, was 1,402,861, an increase over the same date in 1929 of 20,039, but this was the smallest increase recorded during any year since 1915.

There was a decreased number of subscribers in the three Prairie Provinces but all others showed increases.

The average phones per capita of 1911 was greater than in any country except United States where the average is .164 and the total number of telephones was exceeded only by the United States, Germany and Great Britain.
