Mrs. Hamilton Laird, of North Tryon is visiting in Moncton, N. B., the guest of Mr. and Mrs. C. L. Ward.

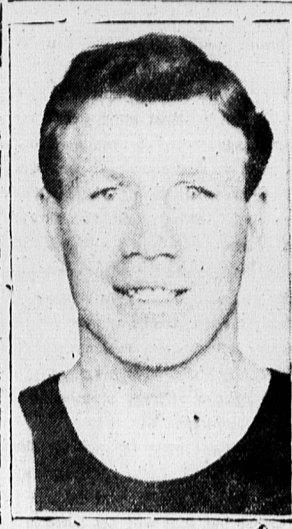
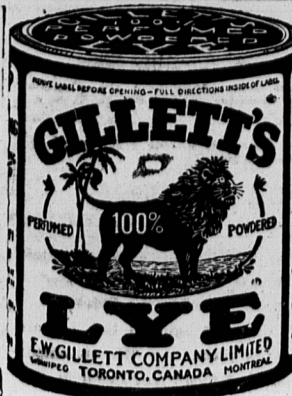

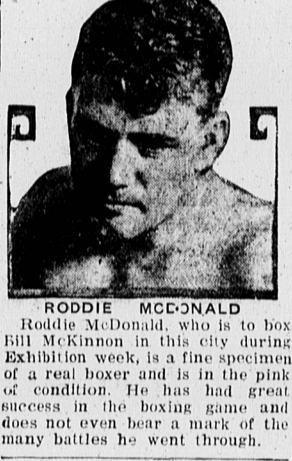

LONDON, Sept. 24.—The council of ambassadors has not yet sent its ultimatum regarding the evacuation of Burgenland, awarded to Austria by the Treaty of Trianon, to the Hungarian Government, but it is understood the terms of the ultimatum have been decided upon. The time limit to be given Hungary for the evacuation of Burgenland, will be ten days to a fortnight. Failure by Hungary to comply with the ultimatum will result in the most severe measures being used by the Allies, the ultimatum will say.
