

ONTARIO IMPOSES TAXES.

Toronto Feb. 1. Ontario will tax the Trust Assurance Companies to make up the deficit caused by the change in the export of logs to the United States. The tax on the insurance is also to be raised.

THE U. S. FORMALLY APOLOGIZES.

Ottawa Feb. 2.—The United States Government has formally apologized for the action of one of its customs officials at Detroit in forcibly deporting a Canadian named Meagher from Essex County to Michigan last September.

SIDE AND PRINCE GO

The funeral of the late Mr. John Goss will take place tomorrow, Saturday afternoon, at 2 o'clock.

The Guardian regrets to record the death of Mr. John Goss of this town, which occurred at his home yesterday evening about 5 o'clock. Deceased was in his 79th year and all who knew him esteemed him highly for his many estimable traits of character. He was a native of Bideford, England, and came to this Island when 19 years of age. Some years afterwards he moved to St. John, N. B., where he resided some years. He settled in Muddy Creek about 32 years ago where he resided until last fall, when owing to failing health, he removed to Summerside. He leaves a widow, three sons, one of them being Mr. John D. Goss of this town, and two daughters, Mrs. Randall in Canton, Mass., and Mrs. Polly, of Upper Cape, N. B., to all of whom the Guardian extends its deepest sympathy.

The many and varied duties in connection with the election yesterday were performed very quietly. There was little excitement until evening when matters took a livelier turn, and even the apathetic began to wonder often and sometimes loudly, whom it would be safe to shake by the hand and congratulate. About 6 o'clock it was known in the 5th district Mr. Des Roches had succeeded in polling a majority of 65 and the enthusiasm of his friends equalled in intensity the dejection of the defeated. Many tidings were, however, in store for the Liberals. The returns from the fourth district showed from the start that the Liberal candidate Mr. S. E. Reid, was at the head of the race, the final returns from Searletown giving him a majority of 90.

The poll in the Western district of Summerside was held in the Court House with Capt. D. McKinnon presiding officer. In the Centre at Mr. Archibald McIntosh's residence Mr. John Ramsay presided; in the Eastern, at Mr. John Dickson's ware house, Water St. Mr. John M. Clark presided.
