IMPORTANT MEETING.

An interesting meeting of the Maple Leaf Farmers Institute was held in Alberry Plains School-house on Thursday evening, Oct. 3rd. The President, J. F. Jenkins presided, and submitted to the discussion of the mer questions of much importance. After the members addressed the meet the following resolutions were unanimously adopted:—Resolved that whereas the production of pork this Province, owing to an unsteady unsatisfactory and remunerative market, has fallen off to a great extent, and whereas the production of pork could be turned into a continuous and highly profitable source of revenue, therefore resolved that we the members of Maple Leaf Farmers Institute, consider it, opportune that the farmers of Prince Edward Island should immediately take such steps as would lead to the establishment of a pork packing plant on a co-operative system. And further resolved that this resolution be submitted to the Central Institute for its earnest consideration. And we desire that said Institute take immediate at

to form a Joint Stock Co., Farmers having the first option of providing funds for the erection, equipment and management of a well conducted and up-to-date packing house run on similar lines to those giving such general satisfaction in Denmark.

A resolution was also adopted asking the Central Institute to put a set minimum price on all farm products, potatoes 35c per bus, oats 50c per bus., turnips, 20c, etc.

Peter J. D. Edmonds was appointed a delegate to attend the Central Institute meeting to be held in Charlottetown on the 15th and 16th of October.

Mr. Edmonds expressed his approval of the resolutions and that he would do his utmost to have them carried into effect.

At the close of the meeting a number of lambs were offered for sale. Offers for same to be received by the Secretary Jas. McEachern.

stores or truck them around town as they would have been obliged to do if there were no market. It is a convenience to the country people. We believe it pays them and that the great majority of them appreciate it, and are quite satisfied to add the extra toll to the price of their goods—if they can get it—or, if the worst comes to the worst, to pay it themselves.

There are many in Charlottetown who would abolish the market altogether. This, we believe, would be a mistake. Market and market days have become a regular institution which most of the citizens would part with with regret. It means a rush of business on at least two days in the week, and, although many merchants regard this as objectionable because of the extra help required on those days, the rush and the activity have an awakening effect upon business generally. We need the market, and those who patronize it either as sellers or buyers would be quite content to share the expense between them; if the agitators would keep their hands off. We do not believe in restrictions in trade of any kind but the market is a privilege, not a business proposition and those who enjoy the privilege, either as buyers or sellers, have a right to pay for it. As far as the City is concerned the market should be self-sustaining.

BALKAN FIGHTING.

(Canadian Press) LONDON, Oct. 17.—Balkan fighting remains limited to the Montenegrin Border and although the relations of Turkey with the other allied states is virtually broken, there is a curious indisposition on the part of Bulgaria and Serbia to take a final place in the hostilities. The conclusion of peace between Italy and Turkey has greatly relieved the shipping trade owing to the heavy insurance premiums imposed during the activities of the Italian fleet in Turkish waters.

TOWN OF BERANA CAPTURED.

(Canadian Press) PODGORITZA, Montenegro, Oct. 17.—Montenegrins have captured Berana after ten days fighting. Seven hundred Turkish soldiers were made prisoners. Fourteen guns were taken and a large quantity of ammunition and provisions. In the final attack Montenegrins had ten men killed and thirty-one wounded. Servians, many of whom reside in the town of Berana, hailed the Vukitch and his victorious troops as their deliverers. General Martinovitch, after a short engagement yesterday occupied the fortified section of Mount Mooritch opposite
