GOOD WORDS FOR THE ISLAND.

His Honor Lieutenant Governor Fraser of Nova Scotia is officially and otherwise a man of weight in Canada.

Those who have seen and heard him during the days when he visited this Province in a political campaign know how much of good humor and geniality he was wont to mix with the sledge hammer blows which he dealt out to his Tory opponents.

He is out of politics now, however, and after the manner of Governors is from time to time opening exhibitions and fairs or presiding on notable occasions or delivering patriotic addresses in his own distinctive way.

The other day Governor Fraser spoke at the annual meeting of the Nova Scotia Fruit Growers' Association held at Berwick, in the fine Annapolis Valley, where they are talking this year about a million dollar apple crop.

In Prince Edward Island there are more advantages than in Nova Scotia. The Island is the richest farming country in the world, if the savings banks deposits were divided among its one hundred thousand population there is about even hundred dollars for each of them.

These are good words, because they are true. Governor Fraser knows Prince Edward Island, the Dominion and the United States well, and he was not speaking in Berwick to flatter but to instruct the people who were listening to him there.

The Governor went on to advise the young men of Nova Scotia to stay at home, just as The Guardian has all along advised the young men of this Province to stay at home. We repeat his words with the object in view of driving home that lesson.

There is no better country under the sun than Prince Edward Island, if only we had open communication all the year round, and we shall get that before long. Think of it. "The richest farming country in the world," is what Governor Fraser says, and he makes the statement deliberately in another Province, judging by what he has seen and the records of bank deposits.

If so much can be said on such high authority under present conditions, what would be our prosperity if we had the Tunnel? Once that great work is begun every man woman and child in Prince Edward Island would be doubly proud of his native Island and its prosperity, and would be saying with the late lamented Mr. Tarte, "Wait till you see us next year!"
