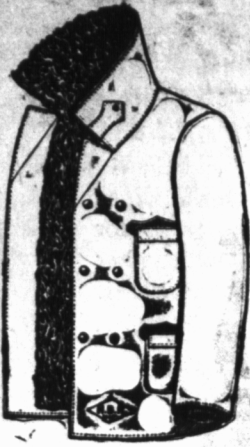

### SAYS McLAREN FIRED THE SHOT

BUCKINGHAM, Que., Oct. 28.—The coroner's inquest on the bodies of the two strikers killed in the McLaren riot opened here today with Coroner McMahon on the bench. At the morning sitting the most interesting evidence was given by one of the strikers named Clement who swore that Alex. McLaren fired the shot which killed Belanger.

At the afternoon session Aurora Beauty, daughter of the recorder of Buckingham, testified to being a witness of the riot. She saw revolvers among the crowd when the riot started, and some carried rifles in their way up river.

Chief of Police Kiernan swore that when Belanger came up to demand that the men stop working he saw a revolver in his pocket. He did not arrest him, because he hoped to avoid trouble.

### SOUTH AFRICA CONQUERED A NEW

LONDON, Oct. 27.—All Central Africa is going to be made perfectly habitable for the white man. Its agricultural, industrial and commercial resources will become available. The Nile and their tributaries will team with the commerce of a numerous and happy people.

Henry S. Wellcome, who makes this prophecy, is an American chemist and bacteriologist long resident in London. Six years ago he went to the Sudan. "Disease was rampant," he said. "People, livestock, and growing crops were perishing almost without a finger lifted to stay the calamity. I was granted permission to found what have been named the 'Wellcome Research Laboratories,' which were accommodated in five rooms of the east wing of the Gordon Memorial college at Khartoum. The fitting of these laboratories with every modern appliance and apparatus was completed a man of great experience in combating tropical diseases was made director. Later Dr William Beam of America, an authority on economic chemistry, was put in charge of the chemical department. The staff, hard at work since its formation, has stamped out malaria in the Sudan by exterminating the millions of malarial-bearing mosquitoes that swarmed about Khartoum in the upper reaches of the Nile frequented by soldiers, sailors, boatmen, traders and travellers.

OTTAWA, Ont., Oct. 27.—Another event has occurred which tends to confirm the belief of a large number of scientific men that the ocean currents along the Atlantic coast of Canada are changing and the colder waters are being replaced by warmer. Prof. Prince, commissioner of fisheries, recently received for identification parts of a large fish taken at Hanigan Cove, Nova Scotia. It has been found the fish is a tarpon or giant herring, the greatest of ocean game fishes and a native of the Florida and Mexican coasts. This is the first one taken as far north as Canada.

Other warm water fish received in Canadian waters by the marina biologists in the last few years are Spanish mackerel, sword fish, tunny and other tropical sharks. The dog fish, which has become so numerous in Canadian waters of late, was only met with in southern waters until recently.

### JAP-AMERICAN TROUBLE OVER

LONDON, Oct. 28.—In a despatch from Tokyo the correspondent of the 'Daily Telegraph' says the Japanese Foreign Office has received a reply through their ambassador, Viscount Shino Aoki, at Washington, to the effect that the exclusion of San Francisco children from the schools of the United States Government was not swayed by the details of the incident until after the receipt of the Japanese from Japan. The United States Ambassador in Tokyo, Mr. Luke T. Wright, has given a pledge that the United States will not discriminate between Japanese and other foreign children, and that she undertakes to protect Japanese interests fully. Baron Kentaro Kaneko, a member of the Privy Council, the correspondent continues in the course of an interview on this subject, said the incident was lamentable in view of the ever-increasing friendship between Japan and the United States. He applauded the moderate tone of the Japanese press, which he declared to be based on gratitude. He said further there was no doubt evidence that Japan was deeply pained at the action of the San Francisco authorities, but it was universally held that the exclusion of the Japanese children from San Francisco schools was an outcome of the present election campaign in the United States.
