Latest Official Estimate Can. Potato Production

The third estimate of the 1948 potato crop was released by the Bureau of Statistics on November 16. Production is now estimated at 92,455,000 bushels, 23% larger than the 1947 crop of 75,100,000 bushels and the biggest Canadian crop since 1924. The present estimate represents an increase of about 6% million bushels over the October forecast, practically all of which is in the five eastern provinces. Yields per acre improved from the national average of 152 bushels in 1947 to the current figure of 182 bushels. Details of yields and production, together with comparisons, follow:

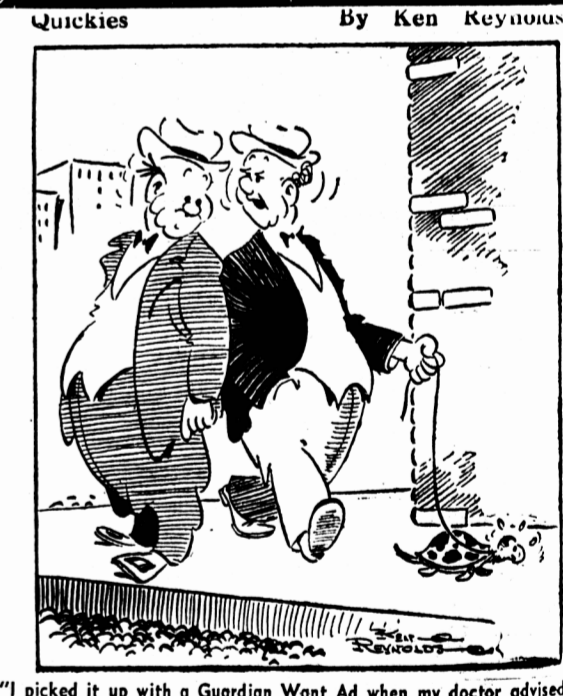
