Stock Markets

At A Glance

WINNIPEG, May 9 - (CP) - Eye futures reacted from the announcement Germany has surrendered unconditionally today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange and sparked by advance of more than two cents at Chicago reached new seasonal high.

CHICAGO, May 9 - (AP) - Liquidation of wheat and rye unsettled the remainder of the grain futures list today and markets were weak to heavy. Rye at times was as much as 2 3-8 cents lower but slight rallies developed during the final hour.

MONTREAL, May 9 - (CP) - Golds moved up to a new six-year high in the indices and selected Base Metals, Papers, constructions and heavy industries were firmer while utilities had a softer undertone in trading today on the Stock Markets in the first session following V-E day. Junior mines were active and mixed.

NEW YORK, May 9 - (AP) - The Stock Market reacted from recent highs today in a late burst of selling which drove leaders down fractions to more than 2 points. The downturn came in the last 20 minutes of trading and was attributed to an expected technical correction after advances which had sent some pivots to 8-year highs. Profit-taking accounted for part of the decline.

TORONTO, May 9 - (CP) - In the first market following the end of the war in Europe, stocks advanced on the Toronto board today. The buoyancy was displayed in the first hour when the action was the heaviest. Thereafter trading slackened and prices turned soft in the gold group while holding firm through the rest of the session.
