To the bereaved family and friends we tender our sincere sympathy while assured that they sorrow not as those who have no hope.

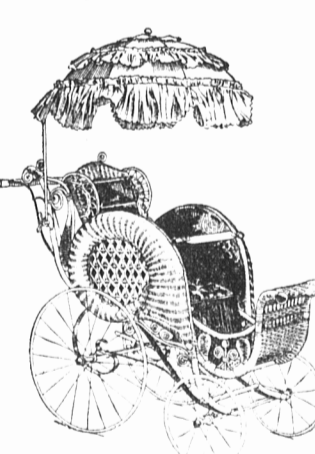
