### MYSTERIOUS AIRCRAFT

The People of Cardiff Have an Unusual Sight

Cardiff was startled by the appearance over the city of an aircraft. It was exactly 8.40 when the craft was noticed, and a crowd assembled outside the Glamorgan County Police Station watching its quick progress.
