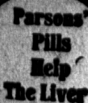

SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

THE SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON. April 6. JACOB AND ESAU. Gen. 25: 27-34; 27: 1-45. GOLDEN TEXT.

"Jehovah is a God of justice; blessed are all they that wait for Him." Is. 30: 18.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS.

By Rev. D. W. Snider. The Golden Text given with this lesson is strikingly suggestive in its application to the root sin of Rebekah and Jacob, which begot their lying and treachery as revealed in the narrative. When they conspired to outwit Isaac and to over-reach Esau they forgot this eternal verity, "Jehovah is a God of justice," and likewise they forgot this unfailing promise, "Blessed are all they that wait for Him."

The trouble with Rebekah was her insatiable ambition for Jacob, Mother-like, it was not for herself, but, as fastened upon the one thought of seeking advancement for Jacob, it became an idolatry in his behalf to that extent that it unsewed her, for she sacrificed both wifehood and motherhood and faith in God to gain her desire.

While lacking the initiative and decisive qualities of his mother, Jacob was an all-too-willing tool. He dreaded being caught in the act of carrying out the planned deceit, but, inspired by his mother's nerve and tempted by his own cupidity, which ever relentlessly lay in wait for spoil and advantage, he proceeded on his task. Once in it, sin plucked on sin as he followed lie. He went the limit. Alas, such is the push of one wrong upon another and the relation of crime to crime! Jacob got through with Isaac in his dirty treachery; but the age-long lash of outraged justice smites yet upon his back.

One does not need to seek any defence for Jacob, however, in order to be able to show that he was the better, stronger and altogether more substantial and worthy character when compared with Esau. Esau is lightweight, feeble, vivacious—without depth, abiding purpose or any spiritual longing. Nothing of eternal keeping. He sold his birthright because of a savory smell, saying, "I

will die," unless the mess of pottage should come to his lips. The fact is, there is very little that is commendable which can be said about any of the human personalities with which the lesson and its context has to do. The after history reveals the saving quality in Jacob—that his tenacity of purpose sought and obtained spiritual conquest. But just now he is a lying tool, subject to a deceptive wife and false mother in the presence of a weak, indulgent father, who would pass along the blessing of birthright privilege according to the cravings of his stomach rather than in obedience to the moment would be safe for an hour in will of God.

But the purpose of God is not thwarted. His blessing to mankind finds its way to bless him, as the pure waters from the upper springs find their way to the far-off sea. This and that and the other may appear to be an effectual blockade, but the waters always conquer. So it is with the will of God—"Blessed are they that wait for Him."

The lesson provides a comment upon the sad consequences which follow upon divided parental authority. Jacob was Rebekah's pet and Esau was Isaac's favorite. Every child needs the reciprocal, complementary and mutually strengthening counsel and affection of both father and mother.

A fierce lament over what one has forfeited, even if in the last analysis he was over-reached by the subtle strength of those of deeper quality and greater insight, does not warrant sympathy. It must be understood that what is sold has passed from possession and the seller must abide the consequences. The effects of an evil-doing leave their scar forevermore. Repentance cannot recover them.

Isaac trembled. Why? Esau sought revenge. Why? Isaac's trouble was related to his thought of God and as to the manner in which he had been ready to forestall His will. There is cause for trembling under that guilt. Poor Esau; if he could not get after Jacob, what resource had he? Revenge is the attempt of the defeated to regain lost ground when it is realized that it is lost, indeed.

When anyone wrongs another, tricks him, plays him false, descends to dirty circumvention and deceit to overreach him, he may depend upon it that his conduct will force him into exile. As Jacob sought of necessity to put distance between himself and Esau, so he found that infinite chasms gaped between himself and God.

In like manner, Rebekah advised that Jacob should flee to Haran. It was her old home, about which her son had heard so much he already knew its corners. While poor, blind Isaac was duped by pious reasoning into a consent that Jacob should leave Beersheba and go to Haran, both mother and son knew that his flight was the flight of a fugitive and his necessity the necessity of an exile.

But as Jacob trudged upon his way, one, two, three days, he found that while distance might separate him from Esau, he had still to deal with himself and conscience and his future and One above.
