- 6 Persistent hoarseness or cough.
- 7 Any change in normal bowel habits.

Importance Of Welfare Program Is Emphasized

A good public welfare program is essential to Canadian people today, said Miss Jessie Touzell, assistant executive director of the Canadian Welfare Council, in speaking to the New Brunswick-Prince Edward Island Branch of the Canadian Association of Social Workers, in Saint John recently.

Canada is the third trading nation in the world—this represents significant progress; it reflects a land of wealth and ability, but the final test of our strength and abilities is the progress and development of our people as people, and how well we assure continuance of that development.

Miss Touzell emphasized the need of an adequate standard of assistance. Such a program requires high personnel standards as the service can be only as good as the personnel that operate it. Over many years we have given as a community in provision to aid people; widows, unemployed and handicapped people, sufficient to ease our conscience against actual starvation of fellow citizens and seldom enough to maintain self-respect, physical energy, or make possible genuine re-establishment.

The meeting was held in the health centre, 29 Wellington Row—the President, Miss Kathleen Morrissey, was in the chair.

Reports of various committees were heard. Miss Freda Feden, chairman, gave a special report of the membership committee.

Mrs. J. G. Bishop reported that she had attended meetings of the advisory committee of the Health Planning Commission, to which she had been appointed as representative of the Branch.

It was reported at the meeting that the Vice-President, John J. Trainor, had been appointed as Provincial Director of Welfare for Prince Edward Island.
