EDITORIAL NOTES.

It now transpires that the false report on Thursday last of a victory by General Buller and the relief of Ladysmith was a stock-jobbing fake. The hoax seems doubly cruel in the light of the reverses in the field that have so quickly followed.

It is a little strange that no mention is made of Gen. Cleary in Gen. Buller's report from Colenso. Cleary was supposed to be one of the best strategists in the British army and has been prominent in the recent movements in Natal.

The Manitoba Legislature, which had been called to meet December 21st, has been prorogued till January 25th. This will give time to complete the four or five recounts which are pending and for the Greenway Ministry to close out their affairs. The two constituencies of Dauphin and Gimli where the elections were delayed, divided their representatives between the two parties, the first named returning a Liberal and the second a Conservative.

ZION CHURCH.

Greatly Improved—Re-dedication Service Yesterday.

The church was re-dedicated yesterday with three services all of which were largely attended. Rev. J. K. Fraser presided at the morning service, Rev. G. P. Raymond of the Baptist church, in the afternoon and Rev. E. M. Dill in the evening. At the afternoon service the centre pews were reserved for the children of the Sunday school who attended in a body.

The congregation of Zion Church are to be congratulated on the beautiful appearance of their church since the repairs and alterations have been completed. In the basement large beams have been run along under the floor of the main auditorium supported by iron columns. Under the tower a number of stone piers have been placed and the tower and spire have been strengthened by the placing of additional timbers. Under the gallery two iron pillars have been placed. In the ceiling two ventilators have been placed which can be operated from the rear of the building and will afford a perfect ventilation. The pulpit has been brought forward and the additional space has been given to the choir gallery, which has been fitted with some twenty iron choir chairs upholstered in leather. The windows are certainly a vast improvement over the old ones, and the cathedral colored glass gives a very soft light throughout the entire building. The windows were especially selected and were supplied by Messrs Booth and McKay of Toronto. The lighting has been entirely changed and instead of the individual electric lights a beautiful chandelier has been placed in the centre while two other chandeliers of lesser lights are suspended in the wings. The aisles and vestibule have been fitted with linoleum and the choir gallery has been beautifully carpeted. The windows were placed by subscription of the members of the church, and the Ladies' Aid and Young People's Society provided and paid for the furnishing and lights. The outside and interior

of the church have been re-painted, the interior by Mr. Chas. Matheson, who has this time done work of the first quality, and the exterior by Mr. A. Howatt. The basement has been painted by Mr. Dan Howatt. A porch has been built over the main entrance, which has exits on the east and west sides. The trustees of the church have been untiring in their efforts to make the work a success and are certainly to be commended for the present appearance of the church.
