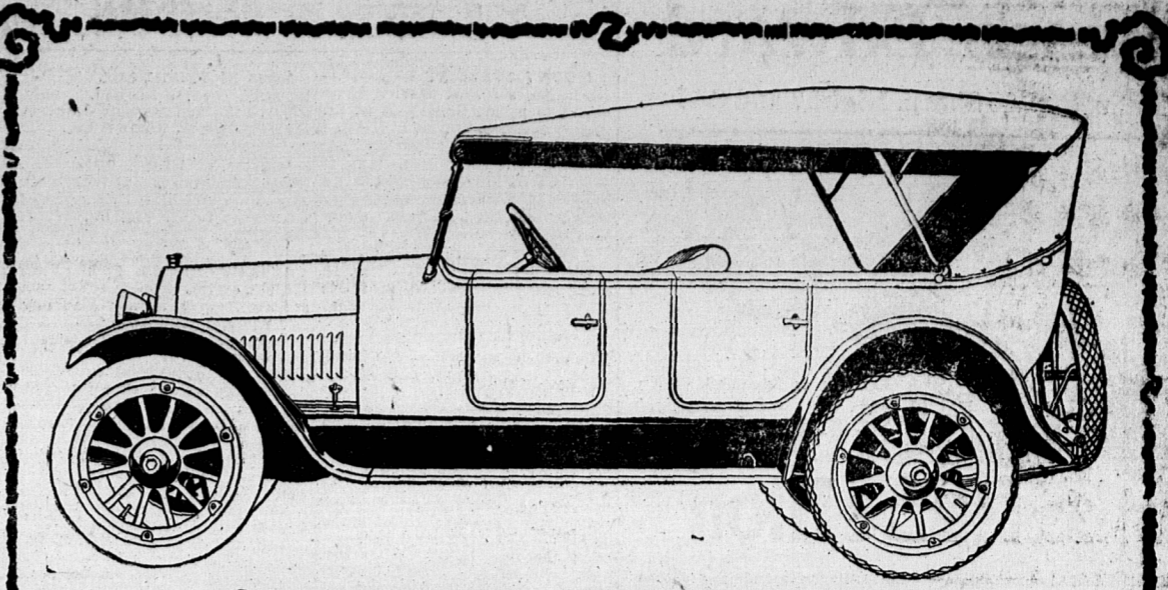

KILLED HIMSELF WHEN ORDERED HOME AGAIN MORRISBURG, Ont., April 3.—Daniel Donohue, aged 27, son of K. J. Donohue, president of the National Bank of Ogdensburg, N. Y., shot himself this morning in a room of the St. Lawrence Hotel here. The bullet entered his body just above the heart. His father and brother were sent for and were at the young man's bedside when he died, a few hours after the af-

fair had taken place. Donohue came to Morrisburg Thursday with the Ogdensburg orchestra to attend a banquet and had been about town since. He was awakened by the hotel clerk and told that his father had telephoned to have him come home at once. Shortly after the delivery of the message a revolver shot was heard. The remains have been taken to Ogdensburg for interment.
